The Singapore Botanic Gardens Research Fellowships

Annually, the Singapore Botanic Gardens (SBG) gives four to five Research Fellowships to outstanding botanists to encourage taxonomic research on the region's flora that will lead to publications of international standard.

The SBG Fellowship awards a maximum amount of S\$ 4500 to pay for the return airfares and hotel stay of the recipient in Singapore for 3-4 weeks. Fellowships with less amount of subsidy for a shorter period of visit will be favourably considered.

Applications are open to botanists who are already working on the region's flora with good publication records. Applicants should hold or have held a faculty or research position at an accredited institution. Priority will be given to projects that can be completed during the Fellowship period and that make use of the SBG Herbarium collection. ASEAN scientists are encouraged to apply.

Applications should consist of an updated curriculum vitae, a one to two-page research project outline, a budget proposal and the names of two referees. Applications will be considered twice a year in **June** and **December**.
